**RESULTS:**

Items 20,21,22 Human deoxyribonucleic acid (DNA) was isolated from the known blood samples from D. Tice (Item 20), R. Pauley (Item 21), and G. Farris (Item 22). The samples were amplified and typed at the HLA DQA1 locus and in the PM system (which includes the LDLR, GYPA, HBGG, D7S8, and GC loci). Refer to the table for typing results.

**CONCLUSIONS:**

Based on the above results and the results presented in my Certificate of Analysis dated March 26, 1998, D. Tice (Item 20), R. Pauley (Item 21), and G. Farris (Item 22) are each eliminated as a possible contributor of the genetic material detected in the sperm and non-sperm fractions of the blanket stain (Item 1A), and the swabs from the knife (Item 16A). They are also each eliminated as a possible co-contributor to the mixtures of genetic material detected in the non-sperm fraction of stain 1 from D. Williams' underpants (Item 11C1), and from the left hand fingernail clippings from M. Moore-Bosko (Item 14F).

The results of other requested examinations will be the subjects of separate reports.

The evidence will be available at the Tidewater Laboratory after you have received the results of all requested examinations.
